Dear Parents,

Your child is invited to participate in the regional JAM Kids Day Camp event coming up on Saturday, May 20, 2017 at the Blue Ridge Music Center, located at Milepost 213 along the Blue Ridge Parkway near Galax, VA.

At the JAM Kids Day Camp, young musicians enrolled in JAM programs throughout Southwest Virginia, Northwestern North Carolina and beyond will get the opportunity to meet and play music with other JAM kids, learn from master musicians, and perform for an audience! Participants will be able to choose from different workshop activities related to the instrument they are playing, as well as workshops on playing in a band, using a sound system, mountain dance styles, and singing/songwriting.

Sign-in begins at 11 a.m. and workshop activities start at 12 p.m. This event is FREE to all student participants and open to the whole family, but students must register with this form before 5 p.m. on Monday, MAY 15, to receive a free lunch. Children are welcome to send in registrations until May 19, but they will be responsible for their own lunch. Family members and others who wish to come with their child have the option of buying lunch from the Galax Smokehouse BBQ vendor that will be located on-site. There will be arts and crafts activities for younger children, as well as National Park Service Junior Ranger activities. Participants may also tour the Roots of American Music exhibit inside the Museum. Students are invited to perform with their regular JAM program group at 5 p.m. for an audience of parents and community members.

The Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation, the Blue Ridge Music Center and the National Park Service collaborate with JAM to make this event possible. The Blue Ridge Music Center is located at Milepost 213, or 700 Foothills Rd., Galax, VA 24333. The event is rain or shine with indoor facilities available.
